Summary	<p>Charles Pusey is currently Professor of Medicine, Head of the Department of Renal Medicine, and Head of Postgraduate Medicine in the Faculty of Medicine at Imperial College London. He is also Honorary Consultant Physician and Lead Clinician in the West London Renal and Transplant Centre, and Director of Education at Imperial College Healthcare NHS Trust. He has continued both clinical and laboratory-based research in parallel, and his work has focused on the causes and treatment of glomerulonephritis and systemic vasculitis. He has published over 300 articles on renal disease, contributed chapters to the standard textbooks on renal and general medicine, and edited several books on renal disorders. He has a wide range of teaching commitments at undergraduate and postgraduate levels, and regularly supervises several PhD students. He has a particular interest in clinical academic training, and served as Academic Registrar at the Royal College of Physicians of London. He has previously been President of the Nephrology Section of the Royal Society of Medicine, Chairman of Kidney Research UK, and Director of Research and Development at Hammersmith Hospitals NHS Trust. He was elected Fellow of the Academy of Medical Sciences in 2002 and Senior Investigator of the National Institute of Health Research in 2008.</p>			

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
